Actions from the meeting:

- The walking to school policy has been updated to include information for someone else collecting your child. This will be available next week.
- The pavements outside the school will be monitored next autumn and we will aim to get them cleared of leaves more regularly.
- Out of school hours, the car park provides access to the school field where children can play. As it is a joint-use field, the community are free to use it out of school hours and at weekends. The car park is not a play area for children and the school can be notified with the date and time of any ball games etc being played in this area.
- Some time was spent looking at the external gates and they were found to be adequate.
